**NEEDED ACTION:** We all need to greatly appreciate God's absolute infinite Greatness. We need to realize that as created beings that all we have, that is good, came from Him. Thus, we should search the Scriptures for **ALL** He wants us to become and **ALL** for how we get there. We can begin by studying and appreciating His attributes. God is in charge of our futures.

**THE GREATNESS OF GOD** - God alone is perfect in every attribute. There is no sin or darkness in Him of any kind or any amount. Even though we may have insight, God's infinite Greatness is beyond our comprehension. He is perfect, most holy, and infinitely complete in all possible perfect attributes and character qualities. He has always existed (has pre-existence) and has eternal self existence. He lives in a different domain than we do. He has always known everything that can be known in the past, present, and future (omniscient) simultaneously. In Him, there is nothing new for Him to learn. He interfaces with billions of humans and angels all at the same time. He is everywhere that exists (omnipresent) and has infinite power (omnipotent). He has created a universe so large, we do not know how large it is. There may be no end to it. He is holy, righteous, and truth. Holy, holy, holy is our Lord God almighty. He has mercy, everlasting kindness, grace, and infinite love and glory. He is love and holy. He works with us on an impartial basis. **A listing summary of (many of) God's Attributes is Faithfulness, Glory, Grace, Holiness, Immensity, Immutability, Light, Long-Suffering, Love, Loving-kindness, Mercy, Omnipotence, Omnipresence, Omniscience, Provider, Righteousness, Self-Existence (Eternal Life), Sovereignty, Spirit, and Truth.**

**BENEFITS:** Appreciating God's infinite and absolute Greatness will cause us to love Him greatly. We will learn and keep His commandments and ways of living to have the only and most perfect lives available (that exist). We will go all the way with God. We will have greater incentive to become mature in Christ-Likeness when we have an appreciation for God's infinite and absolute Greatness. We will trust Him to fulfill His many promises, and we will activate our faith by obeying the instructions with the promises. We will memorize them.

**COST (METHOD):** We will study the Bible in detail for all we are to become and do in obedience to Him from our love of Him. Then, we will do all that He commands in obedience to Him.
